GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to administer the Rotorcraft Enterprises Start Pac Power Supply Award for ATEC member schools. Rotorcraft Enterprises is donating one of their Start Pac Model 53025 power supplies. These power supplies are primarily used for various maintenance functions and powering up avionics systems including glass cockpits.

The Start Pac power supplies are available in three models from 25 amps to 105 amps, 28.5 volts DC output. The units are small and the heaviest weighs 20 pounds which allows the unit to be moved easily without need for wheels, tugs or forklifts. The value of this power supply is \$500.00. The Start Pac units are totally protected electrically from over voltage, under voltage, temperature, and overload. They have no duty cycle and can be run at 105% power continuously.

The selection of the school that will receive this award will be made by members of the Northrop Rice Foundation Board. In order to be eligible for consideration a school must be a Northrop Rice Foundation member and an ATEC member school and provide the information requested on the Rotorcraft Enterprises Award Application form.

The deadline for the submission of applications is January 31. The award winner will be announced at the Annual Conference of the Aviation Technician Education Council (ATEC) in Phoenix, AZ, April 14-17, 2012. If the school has not been notified by April 30 it can assume that it has not been successful in this award endeavor.
