GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to administer the Southwest Airline Boeing B737-700NG training scholarship. Southwest Airlines is donating one scholarship per year for one instructor of an NRF Member School. The scholarship provides for attendance in either a two-week Systems or one-week Avionics Course on the Boeing B737-700NG Series airplanes. This training scholarship will be awarded to an instructor selected by the Board of the Northrop Rice Foundation. The Southwest training course will be conducted at the Southwest Headquarters Training facility in Dallas, TX. SWA will provide air transportation and cover the hotel cost. In order to be considered for selection for the Southwest Award the applicant must meet the following requirements.

Scholarship Conditions and Requirement

1. Deadline for the submission of applications is January 31. The name of the recipient will be announced at the ATEC Annual Conference in Phoenix, AZ April 14-17, 2012
2. All applicants must have an A&P Certificate to be eligible, be teaching at an NRF Member School, and have the approval of the school administrator.
3. Only one instructor from any school will be considered unless in the opinion of the selection Committee there be extenuating circumstances.
4. All applicants are required to submit letters of recommendation from two professional persons who are not associated with the school at which the instructor is employed.
5. A description of how past work and accomplishments have resulted in the enhancement of Aviation Maintenance student education.
6. List of subjects taught.
