SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS**

For AMT STUDENTS

- **James Rardon AMT Student of the Year Award** – Winner from an ATEC-member school receives a plaque and trip (airfare, hotel, meals) to the 2016 ATEC conference in Atlanta, Georgia.
- **Aircraft Technical Book Company Book Awards** – Five (5) sets of AMT textbooks, each valued at \$249 per set.
- **ARSA Scholarship** – Financial award of \$1,000 that can be applied toward the winner's tuition, books and/or test expenses.
- **Aventure Aviation Scholarships** – Three (3) scholarships totaling \$2,750, one specifically for an international AMT student.
- **Avotek Book Awards** – Five (5) sets of AMT training textbooks, each valued at \$250 per set.
- **Houston PAMA Chapter Scholarships** – Multiple scholarships totaling \$3,500 for Houston-area AMT students.
- **NRF Aviation Scholarship** – Financial awards up to \$1,000 that can be applied toward tuition, books, tools, and/or test expenses. Multiple scholarships may be awarded.
- **Snap-On Aviation Tool Awards** – Five (5) tool sets each valued at \$4,000.

For AVIONICS STUDENTS

- **Aircraft Technical Book Company** – Five (5) sets of Avionics training textbooks, each valued at \$298 per set.
- **Avotek Book Awards** – Five (5) sets of Avionics training textbooks, each valued at \$270 per set.

For INSTRUCTORS

- **Airbus Helicopters Scholarship** – Two-week helicopter airframe field maintenance course in Grand Prairie, TX (Value \$5,140).
- **Avotek's Dale Hurst Financial Assistance Scholarship** – Financial award up to \$1,500 to cover travel and per diem to attend an upgrade training course provided by industry.
- **FlightSafety International Scholarship** – Two-week King Air maintenance training course in Wichita, KS (Value \$10,300).
- **NRF Aviation Scholarship** – Financial award up to \$1,000 to cover travel and per diem expenses to attend a 2- or 3-day upgrade training course provided by industry.

For SCHOOLS

- **Rotorcraft Enterprises Start Pac Award** – Winner will receive a Model 53025/24 Start Pac power supply valued at \$530 that is used for various maintenance functions and powering up avionics systems.
- **Nida Training Equipment Award** – Winner will receive an Aviation Maintenance Training system valued at \$12,280 that includes a Model 130E Trainer, two programs (Models 1438G and 1438P), Learning Management System, Student Monitoring system, and license.

For VETERANS

- **NRF Aviation Scholarships** – Financial awards up to \$1000 that can be applied toward tuition, books, tools, and/or test expenses of honorably discharged veterans preparing for A&P certification. Multiple scholarships may be awarded.
