CATHY REDSON

“Energizing the 21st Century Learning Environment”

Today’s mantra of “Teacher as Facilitator” requires a new mindset challenging roles and shifting responsibilities in the learning environment. The ability to blend online, mobile and on site training can provide more time to coach hands on skills transfer and mentor students in creative, collaborative teams that decide what, when, and how learning takes place. This approach instills an empowered sense of ownership and a level of commitment that ensures the attainment of desired student outcomes.

Cathy Redson has been an educator for over 20 years at K-12 and community college levels, and since 2008, has trained over 1,500 electricians, roofers, contractors, and displaced professionals for careers in the solar industry. Cathy is a dynamic speaker offering insight on how to integrate hands on, “minds on” training into traditional lesson plans. She relates to experienced educators that recognize the need to challenge students to take responsibility for their learning, but are faced with a vast body of knowledge to cover in a short period of time.
