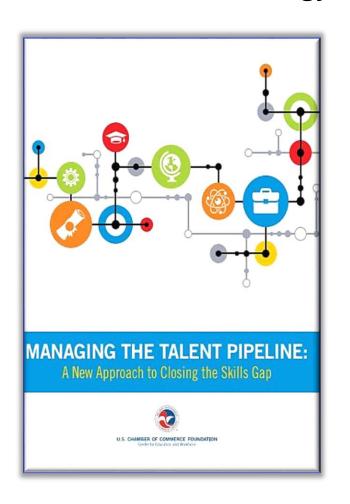

TSC Strategy: Demand-Driven Talent Pipeline Management

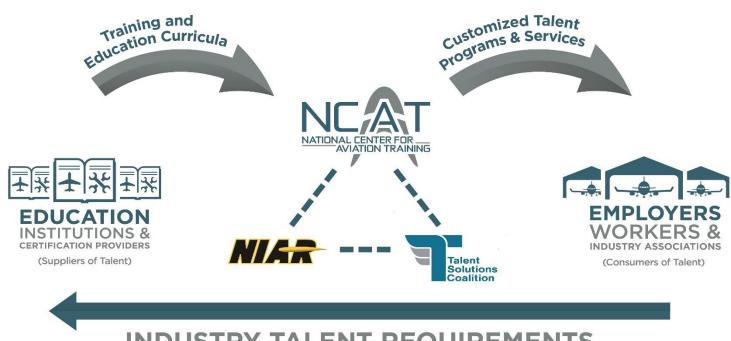


- ✓ Treat employers as end-customers
