A comprehensive, structured approach for delivering academic and CTE that prepare students for postsecondary education and career success.

The Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 (Perkins IV) requires that all eligible providers offer at least one program of study.

National Activities

Section 114 of Perkins IV authorizes OCTAE to provide support directly or through grants, contracts, or cooperative agreements, for research, development, demonstration, evaluation, assessment, capacity-building, and technical assistance activities aimed at improving the quality and effectiveness of CTE programs authorized under Perkins IV.
